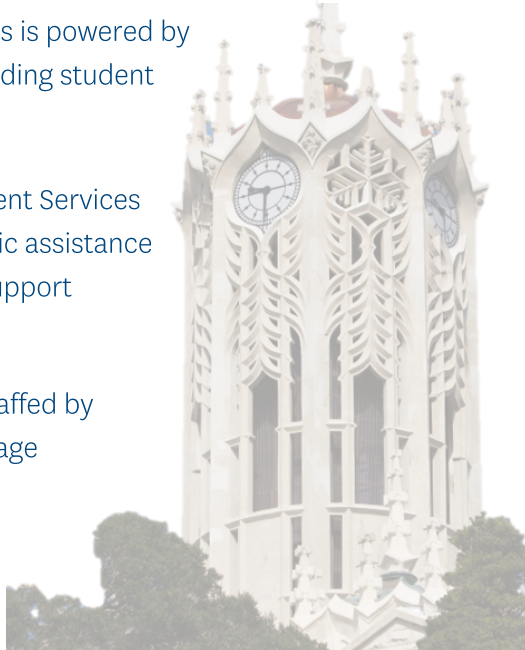

General English Online

General English Online is for students who want to improve their ability to communicate in English in social situations.

These include: introducing yourself, making friends, maintaining relationships, organising travel plans, giving advice, and sharing experiences.

Our students develop their communication skills with practical, real-life activities, projects and presentations. They also improve their vocabulary and grammar with a focus on being able to use this language in a comfortable and confident way.

Our lessons are divided into 2x2 hour lessons (2 hours core skills and language, 2 hours communication skills), five days per week (20 hours per week in total).

Our students also have the option to join a range of free activities including our most popular - Meet2Chat! Meet2Chat is a very special activity where students can have conversations with English speakers from the University of Auckland. Our students take part in quizzes, short presentations and have many other fun opportunities to practice speaking and listening.
