The Ichigaya Tamachi Campus has high-rise facilities consisting of 15 floors.  
To access each floor, proceed from the entrance hall on the first floor and use the elevators.

### Access Route

Please use public transportation to get to the campus.  
From Ichigaya Station, cross the Ichigaya Bridge, turn right at the Ichigaya-mitsuke intersection (★), and go straight on Sotobori-dori Street.



### Train

- A JR Chuo/Sobu Line**  
Approximately five minutes on foot from Ichigaya Station. There is a ramp next to the exit stairs.
- B Toei Subway Shinjuku Line**  
Approximately five minutes on foot from Ichigaya Station (Exit A1). Be careful when accessing the Ichigaya-Mitsuke intersection (★) due to heavy traffic.
- C Tokyo Metro Yurakucho Line and Namboku Line**  
From Exit 5 or 6 on the Yurakucho Line or Exit 7 on the Namboku Line, follow the underground passageway to the elevator leading to the ground level. It is approximately a two-minute walk to the campus from the elevator.

### Restrooms

Barrier-free restrooms are located on 1F and 10F.

### Access routes requiring caution

**Entrance in front of the Health Center and Student Counseling Center**  
The door is hinged and very heavy.

**Priority parking**

All campus facilities are wheelchair accessible, but some areas require caution.

**Priority parking**  
Prior application is required for use. When coming and going between the parking lot and the building, it is possible to use the elevator or ramp.  
The ramp is built with an incline of approximately 7° or more.
